GENERAL INFORMATION AND CANCELLATION POLICIES FOR ARKANSAS WELDING ACADEMY

Refund Policy- The registration fee of one hundred dollars (\$100), book (\$100), and equipment fee (\$500.00) will be retained. AWA will not restock. All tuition paid that exceeds the registration and equipment fee will be refunded based on the cost and length of the program in which enrolled in the following manner:

1. At completion of less than twenty-five percent (25%) of the program, the refund will be made on a pro rata basis.
2. At completion of 25% but less than 50% of the program, the student will be refunded 50% of the tuition.
3. At completion of 50% but less than 75% of the program, the student will be refunded 25% of the tuition.
4. At completion of 75% or more of the program no refund is due the student.

Students shall be refunded immediately when a course is cancelled and there is not a course required for their program of study available. The effective date of the termination, for refund purposes, shall be the last day of attendance. All refunds will be made within thirty (30) calendar days of the effective date of termination. All refunds shall be made according to payor source(s) (grant/scholarship/loan) policy.

Purchase order policy- If tuition is invoiced against a purchase order, a copy of the purchase order must accompany the enrollment form. Terms are NET 30 on all invoiced training.

Housing and meals- Students are responsible for their own housing and meals. AWA does not have food service. Students may bring their own food, or there are several restaurants within the local area.

Insurance and Medical Care- Students are responsible for their own medical care and expenses. Students are not covered by Arkansas Welding Academy insurance.

- (1) 4 1/2" Angle Grinder (not snub nose) all safety must be in working order.
- Tungsten
- TIG Rig
- Clothing appropriate for welding (long sleeve button up shirts, jeans without holes and cut to allow to be pulled over boots and not tucked in, thermal layers for winter).

Also, should any equipment provided by AWA need replaced, it will be purchased by student except for ear protection and clear lens.
